- Social Security cards for you, your spouse, & your children
- Forms, statements or info about income (payroll, scholarships, grants, fellowships, W2, 1099, 1042-S, etc)
- All 1099 forms showing interest, dividends, and capital gains.
- Enroll & Pay Info from KU showing tuition paid & financial aid received or 1098-T form.
- A total of the amount you paid for required course related books, supplies, & equipment in 2017.
- Your checkbook verifying your bank routing & account numbers for direct deposit refunds.
- If you plan to itemize deductions, bring proof of medical expenses, home mortgage interest, gifts to charity, real estate/personal property tax, unreimbursed employee expenses, etc.
- Your KU ID card.
- Copies of your federal & state income tax returns from last year.
- **International students**, please bring your passport & I-20 or DS-2019.
